In Recognition of

Architecture Month in Hawai'i

WHEREAS, Architecture Month recognizes that the Honolulu Chapter of the American Institute of Architects (AIA Honolulu) has promoted design excellence in Hawai'i's built environment since 1926; and

WHEREAS, Architecture Month events and activities are organized and executed by AIA Honolulu's 800 members who have made a commitment to educate the public on architecture and design; and

WHEREAS, Architecture Month is the ninth consecutive year that AIA Honolulu will offer these events that highlight the power of good design in making our communities a better place to live, work and play, and to also generate discussions of design in Hawai'i; and

WHEREAS, Architecture Month recognizes AIA Maui for serving the needs of Maui County, and the AIA Hawai'i State Council for promoting architecture statewide; and

WHEREAS, Architecture Month recognizes the Hawai'i Chapter of the American Society of Landscape Architects for its contributions to beautifying and sustaining Hawai'i's natural and built environments; and
