WHEREAS, the Hawai'i State Bar Association (HSBA) unites and inspires Hawai'i's lawyers by promoting justice, serving the public and improving the legal profession; and

WHEREAS, the Young Lawyers Division (YLD) of the Hawai'i State Bar Association has selected and is promoting the theme of this year's Law Week, "Justice for All"; and

WHEREAS, the YLD shall, in promoting this year's theme, coordinate and conduct Action Line telethons on KHON2 News from April 26 – May 1 and will offer legal clinics, open to the public on May 2, on the islands of O'ahu, Kaua'i, Maui and Hawai'i; and

WHEREAS, the clinics shall provide pro bono legal services to the community by providing free legal information and referrals to other nonprofit legal organizations; and

WHEREAS, volunteer lawyers shall be at the clinics to help educate the public on various areas of law and share free legal information with those who attend; and

WHEREAS, the telethons and clinics are presented in conjunction with the American Bar Association's National Law Day on May 1, which celebrates the rule of law and underscores how law and the legal process have contributed to the freedoms all Americans share:
