



Island State Recreational Area," containing an area of 2.310 acres, SUBJECT, HOWEVER, to portions of Parcel 1 of Perpetual Non-Exclusive Sewer Easement, Sand Island Outfall, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, both being designated C.S.F. No. 25,447 and dated September 9, 2015.

SUBJECT, HOWEVER, to the condition that upon cancellation of this executive order or in the event of non-use or abandonment of the premises or any portion thereof for a continuous period of one (1) year, or for any reason whatsoever, the State of Hawaii, Department of Land and Natural Resources, Division of State Parks shall, within a reasonable time, restore the premises to a condition satisfactory and acceptable to the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii.

SUBJECT, FURTHER, to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.

This executive order does not authorize the recipient of the set aside to sell or exchange or otherwise relinquish the State of Hawaii's title to the subject public land.



Kaholaloa, Sand Island, Honolulu, Oahu, Hawaii

Comprised of the following:

- A. Portion of the Former Kaholaloa Fishery restored to the Territory of Hawaii by Presidential Executive Order 9752 dated July 15, 1946.
- B. Portion of Parcel 2 of Quitclaim Deed: United States of America to the State of Hawaii dated July 23, 1965 and recorded in Liber 5334, Page 226 (Land Office Deed S-24133).

Beginning at the northeast corner of this parcel of land and on the southwest corner of Sand Island Sewage Treatment Plant, Public Health and Ancillary Site, Governor's Executive Order 3939, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "U.S.E. NORTH BASE" being 132.51 feet North and 3785.85 feet West, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 284° 43' 300.00 feet along Sand Island Sewage Treatment Plant, Public Health and Ancillary Site, Governor's Executive Order 3939;



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2. 64° 00' 471.64 feet along Sand Island State Recreational Area,  
Governor's Executive Order 2704;
3. Thence along Sand Island State Recreational Area, Governor's Executive Order 2704 on a  
curve to the right with a radius of 200.00 feet, the  
chord azimuth and distance being:  
108° 23' 279.78 feet;
4. 244° 00' 444.23 feet along the remainder of the Former Kaholaloa  
Fishery to the point of beginning and containing  
an AREA OF 2.310 ACRES.

SUBJECT, HOWEVER, to portions of Parcel 1 of Perpetual Non-Exclusive  
Sewer Easement, Sand Island Outfall as shown on plan attached hereto and made a part hereof.

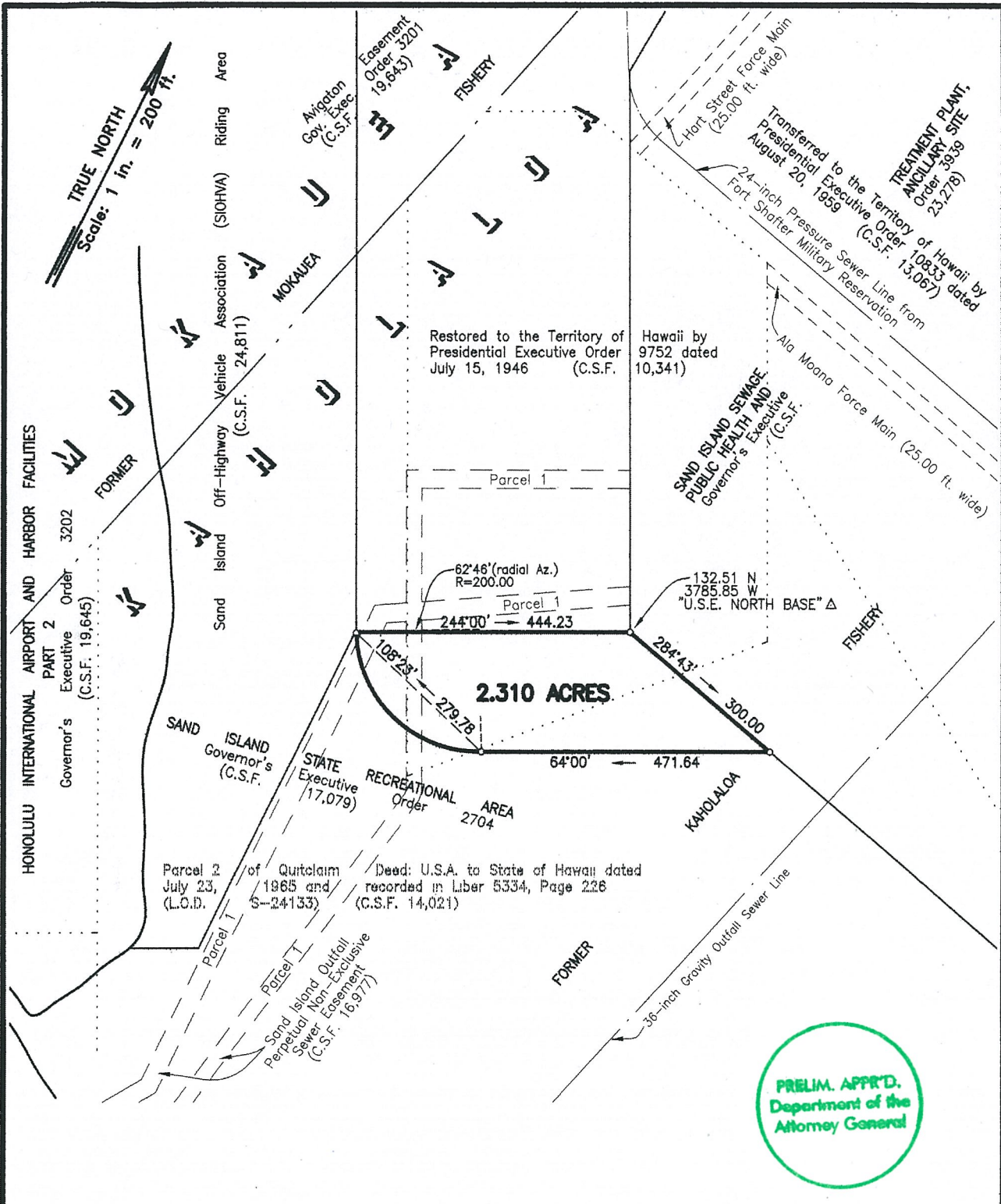
