WHEREAS, Carole Kai is a well-known local entertainer whose name has become synonymous with charitable giving; and

WHEREAS, Carole credits her legendary drive to give back to the community to her late mother, Ethel Iwamoto Shimizu, whose favorite saying was "You must put back water in the well when you take it out so others can drink too!"; and

WHEREAS, Carole took this advice to heart and credits her mother for inspiring her charity work with organizations and causes in Hawai'i, Guam, Thailand, Hong Kong, Indonesia and Malaysia; and

WHEREAS, for decades, Carole has inspired others to follow her lead and to "Be driven by your passion to be good and to do good"; and

WHEREAS, Carole is perhaps best known for creating and sponsoring "The Carole Kai International Bed Race", which raised millions of dollars for 50 charities and the military from 1974 to 1994; and

WHEREAS, Carole co-founded "The Great Aloha Run" in 1985 with Dr. Jack Scaff, an annual 8.15 mile charity run which continues to host more than 29,000 entrants, and has raised almost \$10 million to date and has supported 150 different Hawai'i charities and the military; and

WHEREAS, the Hawai'i chapter of the March of Dimes has received donations through "The Great Aloha Run" over the years, investing in programs and services promoting healthy pregnancies and babies, and working to prevent premature birth and birth defects in communities throughout Hawai'i; and

WHEREAS, Carole's philanthropic legacy was recognized when she was named the 2015 recipient of the March of Dimes Franklin Delano Roosevelt Award for Distinguished Community Service;
