Design Idea: BALANCED ASSESSMENT FOR LEARNING

Our Hawaii public schools will be guided by a core belief that educational assessments will be conducted in the service of student learning, and all educators possess the assessment literate skills for reflection and refinement of professional practice.

Input from post it notes and chart papers:

Performance tasks Portfolios
Authentic assessments

Assessments should be given to guide instruction and should not be the curriculum
A variety [of] teacher developed assessments that are consistent work best
ELLs need designed assessments for them, not just taking assessments for native speakers. Measure ELL gains with focused assessments/instruction.
Students with IEPs must be able to access general ed. curriculum/classes not be restricted. I've seen "alternate assessments" keep students with IEPs from accessing general ed. Curriculum, electives, content.
How can we have a way to assess: teamwork? team project? team product? Solving real project based problems that show critical thinking
Students with IEPs should not be only given tests made by teacher for IEP goals. This practice limits what student is taught or is able to access in a school.
<u>Speech & language assessments</u> Students with disabilities in communication & speech need instruction in the manner/mode of communication they choose, as well as developing language & new vocabulary.
Multiple types of assessment (authentic assessment, portfolio) to personalize learning
Assessment that allows students to reflect based on their work.
Assess the GLOs
Consider alignment of the various assessments e.g. ACT & SBAC don't seem to be well aligned
Need flexibility Consider application for the pilot assessments
Rather than always use traditional program evaluation conduct developmental evaluation [sic]
Next generation science students are a positive change
Accountability alignment with what matters
Support and professional development

Don't count SpEd or ELL schors that lowers school scores/points [sic]
Have state offices create statewide assessment by creating it from the individual schools/complexes schoolwide assessment process. E.g. GLO's commonalities across all schools
Change emphasis from standards & curriculum to assessments that matter to kids

Incorporate student reflection as part of formative assessment Lexiles are important at each grade levels.
