WITHDRAWING LAND FROM THE OPERATION OF GOVERNOR'S PROCLAMATION DATED AUGUST 24, 1905 AND JUNE 12, 1907 AS MODIFIED BY GOVERNOR'S PROCLAMATION DATED MAY 2, 1938

WHEREAS, by Governor's Proclamation dated August 24, 1905 and June 12, 1907 as modified by Governor's Proclamation dated May 2, 1938, certain lands and improvements situate at Honomanu, Hana, Maui, Hawaii were set aside for forest reserve; and



WHEREAS, the Board of Land and Natural Resources at its meeting of February 13, 2015, approved the withdrawal of a portion of land from said proclamation.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, DAVID Y. IGE, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Section 183-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, do hereby order that the following described land, identified as "Withdrawal Portion of Koolau Forest Reserve, Governor's Proclamation dated August 24, 1905 and June 12, 1907 as modified by Governor's Proclamation dated May 2, 1938," situate at Honomanu, Hana, Maui, Hawaii, containing an area of 7.80 acres, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, being designated as C.S.F. No. 25,502 and dated April 26, 2016, is hereby withdrawn from the Operation of Governor's Proclamation dated August 24, 1905 and June 12, 1907 as modified by Governor's Proclamation dated May 2, 1938.

SUBJECT to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.
