



WHEREAS, the Board of Land and Natural Resources at its meeting of February 13, 2015, approved the withdrawal of a portion of land from said proclamation.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, DAVID Y. IGE, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Section 183-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, do hereby order that the following described land, identified as "Withdrawal Portion of Koolau Forest Reserve, Governor's Proclamation dated August 24, 1905 and June 12, 1907 as modified by Governor's Proclamation dated May 2, 1938," situate at Honomanu, Hana, Maui, Hawaii, containing an area of 7.80 acres, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, being designated as C.S.F. No. 25,502 and dated April 26, 2016, is hereby withdrawn from the Operation of Governor's Proclamation dated August 24, 1905 and June 12, 1907 as modified by Governor's Proclamation dated May 2, 1938.

SUBJECT to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.



Honomanu, Hana, Maui, Hawaii

Being a portion of the Government (Crown) Land of Honomanu.

Beginning at the south corner of this parcel of land and on the mauka or southwest side of Hana Highway, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "PUU OKOHOLA" being 2376.52 feet North and 2104.14 feet East, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 124° 38' 905.45 feet along the remainder of Koolau Forest Reserve, Governor's Proclamation dated August 24, 1905 and June 12, 1907 as modified by Governor's Proclamation dated May 2, 1938;
2. 218° 35' 84.97 feet along the mauka or southeast side of Hana Highway;





3. 209° 35' 69.14 feet along the mauka or southeast side of Hana Highway;
4. 222° 30' 94.80 feet along the mauka or southeast side of Hana Highway;
5. 233° 20' 149.03 feet along the mauka or southeast side of Hana Highway;
6. Thence along the mauka or south side of Hana Highway on a curve to the right with a radius of 76.00 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being:  
270° 30' 91.38 feet;
7. 307° 40' 52.07 feet along the mauka or south side of Hana Highway;
8. 316° 30' 58.07 feet along the mauka or south side of Hana Highway;
9. Thence along the mauka or south side of Hana Highway on a curve to the left with a radius of 218.00 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being:  
299° 17' 129.05 feet;
10. 282° 04' 75.00 feet along the mauka or south side of Hana Highway;
11. Thence along the mauka or southwest side of Hana Highway on a curve to the right with a radius of 92.00 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being:  
316° 17' 103.47 feet;
12. 350° 30' 104.82 feet along the mauka or southwest side of Hana Highway;
13. 342° 10' 86.78 feet along the mauka or southwest side of Hana Highway;
14. 306° 50' 129.96 feet along the mauka or southwest side of Hana Highway;



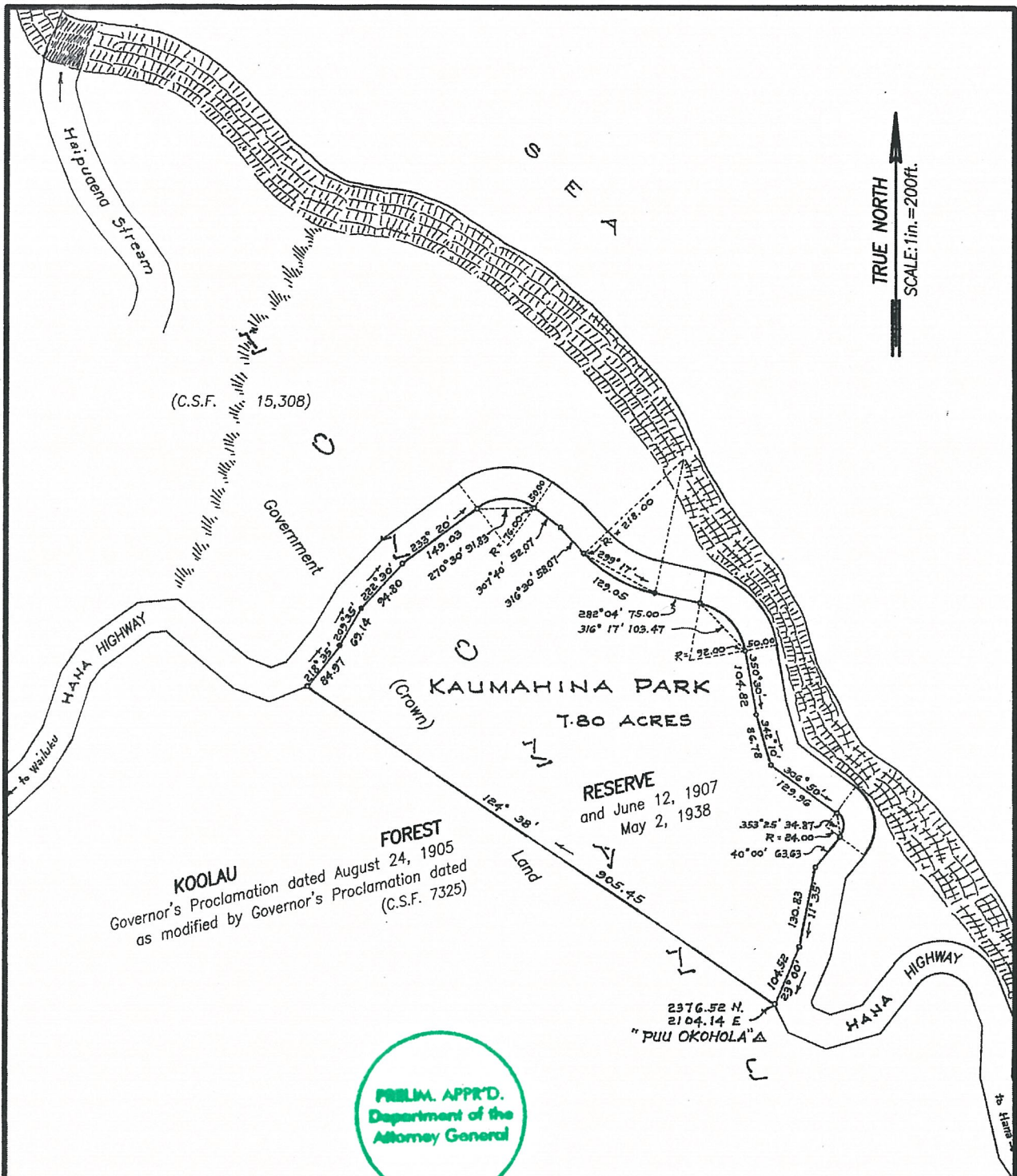
- 15. Thence along the mauka or west side of Hana Highway on a curve to the right with a radius of 24.00 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being:  
353° 25' 34.87 feet;
- 16. 40° 00' 63.63 feet along the mauka or west side of Hana Highway;
- 17. 11° 35' 130.83 feet along the mauka or west side of Hana Highway;
- 18. 23° 00' 104.52 feet along the mauka or west side of Hana Highway to the point of beginning and containing an AREA OF 7.80 ACRES.
