

Proclamation in Recognition of

Kupuna Power Day

WHEREAS, Hawai'i State Senator Brickwood Galuteria will be hosting the fourth annual Kupuna Power Day Wednesday, April 6, 2016, from 9:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. at the Hawai'i State Capitol, an event that celebrates our kupuna and provides important information relating to seniors, and features notable local entertainers and activities such as Zumba; and

WHEREAS, Kupuna Power Day organizers recognize that at the time of the 2010 U.S. Census, 14.3% or 183,040 of Hawai'i's residents were age 65 and over and that, while our state's total population went up 12.3% from the 2000 Census, the number of residents 65 or older grew by more than 20%; and

WHEREAS, a recent study conducted by the America Association of Retired Persons Hawai'i (AARP Hawai'i) found nearly four out of five Hawai'i seniors say it would be very important to them to have a "central place where they could get information about long-term care services as well as information on services and benefits available to them and their families"; now

THEREFORE, I, DAVID Y. IGE, Governor, and I, SHAN S. TSUTSUI, Lieutenant Governor of the State of Hawai'i, do hereby proclaim April 6, 2016 as

in Hawai'i and urge the people of The Aloha State to join in encouraging seniors to stay healthy and active, recognizing the efforts of Hawai'i State Senator Brickwood Galuteria, and mahalo organizers of the 4th Kupuna Power Day for empowering our kupuna.
