442<sup>nd</sup> Veterans Club

WHEREAS, the 442<sup>nd</sup> Veterans Club was organized by veterans of the 442<sup>nd</sup> Regimental Combat Team, a Japanese American military unit that fought gallantly in eight military campaigns in Europe during World War II; and

WHEREAS, members of the 442<sup>nd</sup> Veterans Club include soldiers assigned to the 442<sup>nd</sup> Regimental Combat Team consisting of the 442<sup>nd</sup> Infantry Regiment, the 552<sup>nd</sup> Field Artillery Battalion, the 232rd Engineer Company and the 206<sup>th</sup> Army Band; and

WHEREAS, the Nisei soldiers gained respect and honor as a great military unit by the end of the war; and to this day, the 442nd remains the Army's most highly decorated combat unit in U.S. history for its size and length of service; and
