## National Window Film Day

**WHEREAS**, window film is proven to be one of the most cost-effective means of reducing our carbon footprint, resulting in significant savings in energy; and

**WHEREAS**, window film is an affordable alternative for homeowners as they update their homes with energy efficient options; and

**WHEREAS**, the use of window film helps both consumers and businesses save money on their energy bills and reduce peak demand for electricity when utilities are challenged to meet those needs; and

**WHEREAS**, window film provides a safer, healthier and more secure environment for homeowners, commercial buildings, retail establishments, hospitals, hotels and condominiums; and

**WHEREAS**, window film holds glass together upon breakage, making it safer for building occupants; and

**WHEREAS**, professionally installed window film can block up to 99 percent of UV rays from passing through glass windows; and

**WHEREAS**, window film on automobiles helps block out dangerous solar rays from negatively affecting the health of Hawai'i drivers by shielding their eyes from solar glare and protecting their skin to prevent cancer; and

**WHEREAS**, the majority of window film products is manufactured in the United States by companies that create job opportunities and provide economic benefits at all levels of employment; and

**WHEREAS**, the window film industry is committed to raising public awareness of all the benefits of window film through the International Window Film Association, a nonprofit trade association; and

**THEREFORE I, DAVID Y. IGE**, Governor, and **I, SHAN S. TSUTSUI**, Lieutenant Governor of the State of Hawai'i, do hereby proclaim April 30, 2017 as
