### Her Royal Highness Princess Victoria Kamāmalu



Her Royal Highness Princess
Victoria Kaahumanu Kiheʻaheʻalani Kamāmalu
was the granddaughter
of Kamehameha the Great, the daughter of
High Chiefess and Kuhina Nui Elisabeta Kahoanoku Kīnaʻu
and High Chief Mataio Kekūanāoʻa, Governor of Oahu,
sister of Alexander ʻIolani Liholiho, King Kamehameha IV,
and Lot Aliʻiolani Kapuāiwa, King Kamehameha V.

Princess Kamāmalu was named Kuhina Nui (co-ruler) during the reign of her brother King Kamehameha IV.

She was given the name Kamāmalu after her aunt Queen Kamāmalu who died with her husband King Kamehameha II of the measles during a visit to England.

During her infancy Princess Kamāmalu
was given to John Papa 'Ī'ī
by Kīna'u who instructed him to raise her only daughter.
From birth Princess Kamāmalu was bethroned
to Prince William Lunalilo
by the Prince's mother High Chiefess Miriam Kekāuluohi
and High Chiefess Elisabeta Kahoanoku Kīna'u.
During her short life Princess Kamāmalu was an accomplished
chanter, poet and was the original founder
of the 'Aha Hui Ka'ahumanu, Ka'ahumanu Society, which
the Princess named in honor of her aunt Queen Ka'ahumanu,
Kuhina Nui and wife of Kamehameha the Great.

Princess Victoria Kamāmalu was born on November 1, 1838 and died on May 29, 1866,
