WHEREAS, Hawai'i is proud to be home to numerous children's book authors and illustrators; and

WHEREAS, these authors and illustrators portray the rich and diverse cultures of Hawai'i and other locales in their books and works of art; and

WHEREAS, their published works help promote literacy and the love of reading for all ages with stories and topics our island children and youth can identify with; and

WHEREAS, many of these writers and artists visit schools and prisons and engage in community presentations which encourage and inspire others to share their own unique stories; and

WHEREAS, these local literary talents are a vital part of our community and their works are treasures to be enjoyed and celebrated; and

WHEREAS, the Hawai'i State Public Library System and the Society of Children's Book Writers and Illustrators of Hawai'i have partnered to present the first Surf-a-Book Festival at the Hawai'i State Library to celebrate children's literature in Hawai'i; and

WHEREAS, the festival will include free presentations, activities, read alouds, book signings, a book exhibit and panel discussions;

THEREFORE I, DAVID Y. IGE, Governor, and I, SHAN S. TSUTSUI, Lieutenant Governor of the State of Hawai'i, do hereby proclaim September 23, 2017 as
