FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

JUNE 14, 2018

On May 11, 2018, President Donald J. Trump granted a Major Disaster Declaration for the State of Hawaii triggering the release of Federal funds to help people and communities recover from the Kilauea Volcanic Eruption and Earthquakes that began May 3, 2018, and continuing. **This disaster declaration has been amended as indicated below in bold.** Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:

Incident: Kilauea Volcanic Eruption and Earthquakes

Incident Period: May 3, 2018, and continuing

Public Assistance (PA): (Assistance for emergency work and the repair or

replacement of disaster-damaged facilities):

authorized.

Hazard Mitigation (HM): (Assistance for actions taken to prevent or reduce long term

risk to life and property from natural hazards):

HM-Designated Areas: All areas in the State of Hawaii are eligible for

assistance under the Hazard Mitigation Grant

Program.

Additional designations may be made at a later date if requested by the State and warranted by the results of further damage assessments.

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
