



Hawaii Emergency Management Agency — **Building 303**

Please drive slowly entering and in Diamond Head. There is a mix of traffic and pedestrians. The Hawaii Emergency Management Agency has two facilities in Diamond Head State Monument. Enter Diamond Head State Monument from Diamond Head Road and drive up the road to reach Kahala Tunnel. Go through the tunnel and take the first right to the road leading to the **Emergency Operations Center (Battery Birkhimer)**. Parking is on the right side of the lot. Enter the double doors of the EOC and press the call button on the right for access. Call 808-733-4300 if lost. If you are going to the **Building 303**, take the second right out of the tunnel.

4) Two double-gate entries on the right when exiting Kahala Tunnel. First gate (1) leads to the State EOC in Battery Birkhimer; the second gate (2) to Building 303. If you pass two red signs on the right, you're heading to the trail.

Dining Options near Diamond Head

Takes a minimum of 5-10 minutes driving to get to these spots. Take-out would be your best bet.
