EXECUTIVE ORDER NO.

SETTING ASIDE LAND FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES

BY THIS EXECUTIVE ORDER, I, the undersigned, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority in me vested by Section 171-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, and every other authority me hereunto enabling, do hereby order that the public land and improvements hereinafter described be, and the same is, hereby set aside for the following public purposes:

FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL PURPOSES, to be under the control and management of the State of Hawaii, Department of Education, being that parcel of land situate at Kapalama and Mokaue, Kalihi, Honolulu, Oahu, Hawaii, and identified as "Kalihi Kai Elementary School," containing an area of 2.980 acres, SUBJECT, HOWEVER, to the following:

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
- 1. Perpetual Non-Exclusive Easement for Electric Transmission Pole, Parcel 4 covered by Grant of Easement: State of Hawaii to Hawaiian Electric Company, Inc. dated December 26, 1972 and recorded in Liber 8840, Page 125 (Land Office Deed 25,767),
 - 2. Road Set Back,
 - 3. Building Set Back,

more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, both being designated C.S.F. No. 25,687 and dated September 28, 2018.

SUBJECT, HOWEVER, to the condition that upon cancellation of this executive order or in the event of non-use or abandonment of the premises or any portion thereof for a continuous period of one (1) year, or for any reason whatsoever, the State of Hawaii, Department of Education shall, within a reasonable time, restore the premises to a condition satisfactory and acceptable to the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii.

SUBJECT, FURTHER, to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.

This executive order does not authorize the recipient of the set aside to sell or exchange or otherwise relinquish the State of Hawaii's title to the subject public land.
