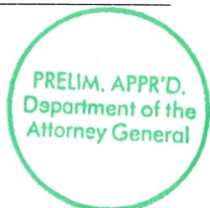
NOW, THEREFORE, BY THIS EXECUTIVE ORDER, I, the undersigned, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority in me vested by Section 171-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, and every other authority me hereunto enabling, do hereby order that the public land hereinafter described be, and the same is, hereby set aside for the following public purposes:

FOR AFFORDABLE HOUSING FOR HOMELESS FAMILIES, INCLUDING ANY REVENUE GENERATING ACTIVITIES ASSISTING THE MANAGEMENT OF THE HOUSING PROJECT PURPOSES, to be under the control and management of the City and County of Honolulu, being those parcels of land situate at Moanalua, Ilinui and Kaliawa, Honolulu, Oahu, Hawaii, and identified as "Affordable Housing Project for Homeless Families Purposes Site," containing an area of 11.300 acres, more or less, all more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, both being designated C.S.F. No. 25,550 and dated October 3, 2016.


SUBJECT, HOWEVER, to the condition that upon cancellation of this executive order or in the event of non-use or abandonment of the premises or any portion thereof for a continuous period of one (1) year, or for any reason whatsoever, the City and County of Honolulu shall, within a reasonable time, restore the premises to a condition satisfactory and acceptable to the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii.

SUBJECT, FURTHER, to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.

This executive order does not authorize the recipient of the set aside to sell or exchange or otherwise relinquish the State of Hawaii's title to the subject public land.

AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROJECT

M. Damon, Deceased to the Territory of Hawaii dated June 20, 1946 and recorded in Liber 2914, Page 438 (Land Office Deed 7993) and being also a portion of the land transferred to the Territory of Hawaii by Presidential Executive Order 10121 dated April 12, 1950.
- B. Portion of Ilinui Fishery (Government) transferred to the Territory of Hawaii by Presidential Executive Order 10121 dated April 12, 1950.
- C. Portion of Ilinui Fishery (Government).
- D. Portion of Kaliawa Fishery acquired by the Territory of Hawaii by FINAL ORDER OF CONDEMNATION, Law No. 16653 dated July 18, 1946 and recorded in Liber 1981, Pages 79-94 (Land Office Deed 7993) and by Quitclaim Deed from the Trustees under the Will and of the Estate of S. M. Damon, Deceased to the Territory of Hawaii dated June 20, 1946 and recorded in Liber 2914, Page 438 (Land Office Deed 7993) and by deed to the Territory of Hawaii by C. Q. Yee Hop and Company, Limited dated May 28, 1929 and recorded in Liber 1010, Pages 24-31 (Land Office Deed 3560).



Beginning at the northwest corner of this parcel of land, on the south side of Nimitz Highway and on the top of bank (makai boundary) on the east side of Moanalua Stream, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "SALT LAKE" being 10,952.52 feet South and 5093.14 feet East, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 283° 18' 33.6" 562.17 feet along the south side of Nimitz Highway;
2. Thence along the south side of Nimitz Highway on a curve to the right with a radius of 2695.75 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being:
285° 39' 24.8" 220.84 feet;
3. Thence along the south side of Nimitz Highway on a curve to the right with a radius of 2695.75 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being:
288° 38' 32" 60.01 feet;
4. Thence along the south side of Nimitz Highway on a curve to the right with a radius of 2695.75 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being:
291° 27' 32.7" 205.00 feet;
5. Thence along the south side of Nimitz Highway on a curve to the right with a radius of 3637.98 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being:
297° 37' 03.8" 37.33 feet;
6. 339° 14' 40" 20.87 feet along the south side of Nimitz Highway;
7. Thence along the south side of Nimitz Highway on a curve to the right with a radius of 2678.75 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being:
294° 53' 06" 12.88 feet;



- 8. 22° 12' 33.50 feet along the top of bank (makai boundary) being also the top of revetment on the westerly side of Kalihi Stream along the remainder of Kaliawa Fishery;
- 9. 11° 18' 26.00 feet along the top of bank (makai boundary) being also the top of revetment on the westerly side of Kalihi Stream along the remainder of Kaliawa Fishery;
- 10. 44° 56' 55.50 feet along the top of bank (makai boundary) on the westerly side of Kalihi Stream along the remainder of Kaliawa Fishery;
- 11. Thence along the top of bank (makai boundary) on the westerly side of Kalihi Stream along the remainder of Kaliawa Fishery, the direct azimuth being:
34° 34' 27.86 feet;
- 12. 111° 48' 21.16 feet along the top of bank (makai boundary) on the westerly side of Kalihi Stream along the remainder of Kaliawa Fishery;
- 13. 30° 22' 42.00 feet along the top of bank (makai boundary) on the westerly side of Kalihi Stream along the remainder of Kaliawa Fishery;
- 14. 57° 32' 53.64 feet along the top of bank (makai boundary) on the westerly side of Kalihi Stream along the remainder of Kaliawa Fishery;

Thence along the top of bank (makai boundary) on the westerly side of Kalihi Stream along the remainder of Kaliawa Fishery for the next three (3) courses, the direct azimuths and distances between points along said top of bank (makai boundary) being:

Thence along the top of bank (makai boundary) on the easterly side of Moanalua Stream along the remainder of Moanalua Fishery for the next six (6) courses, the direct azimuths and distances between points along said top of bank (makai boundary) being:

22. 165° 25' 140.00 feet;

23. 163° 40' 57.00 feet;

24. 192° 33' 70.21 feet;

25. 117° 20' 166.50 feet;

26. 175° 10' 51.85 feet;

27. 212° 45' 20" 25.34 feet to the point of beginning and containing an AREA OF 11.300 ACRES, MORE OR LESS.

Vehicle access shall not be permitted into and from Nimitz Highway over and across Courses 1, 2, 4, 5, 6 and 7 of the above-described Affordable Housing Project for Homeless Families Purposes Site.



TOGETHER WITH the above-described parcel of land, all of the lands seaward of the top of bank (makai boundary) of the above-described Affordable Housing Project for Homeless Families Purposes Site to the Mean Lower Low Water Mark at seashore.

SUBJECT, HOWEVER to the following easements as shown on plan attached hereto and made a part hereof:

4. Portion of Drainage Easement F.

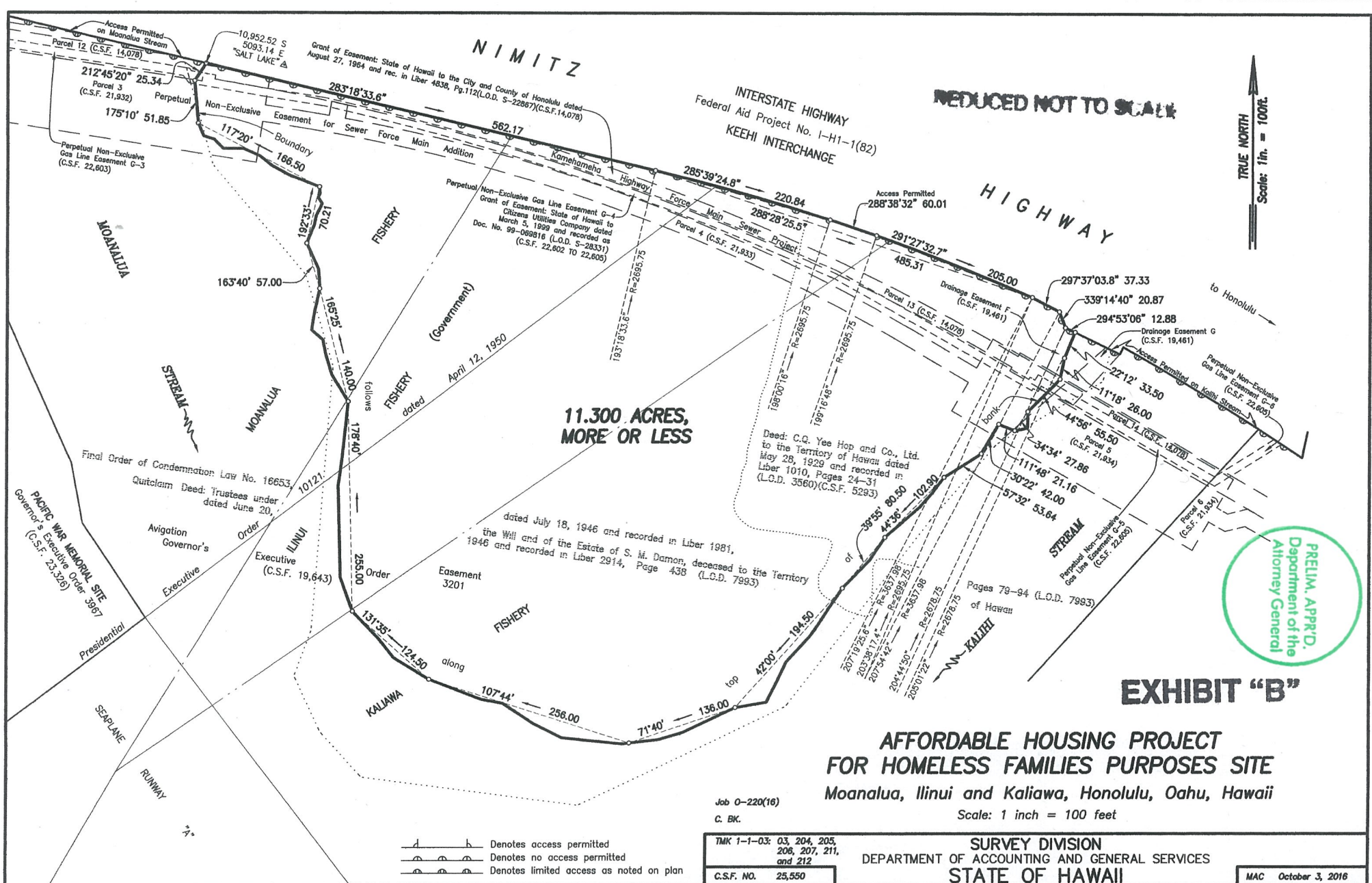
