

Proclamation

WHEREAS, 2019 marks the 27th annual Pineapple Festival on Lāna'i; and

WHEREAS, Lāna'i, also known as the Pineapple Isle, was once an agricultural giant, responsible for 75 percent of the world's pineapple production at one point in time; and

WHEREAS, in the peak of its plantation era, much of the land in Lāna'i were used for pineapple plantations where many immigrant workers settled; and

WHEREAS, today, Lāna'i is a unique vacation destination with a community of generous, welcoming, strong and resilient people; and

WHEREAS, the Pineapple Festival celebrates Lāna'i's plantation heritage, diversity and cultural traditions with many crafts, games, food booths, live entertainment and fireworks; and

WHEREAS, the Pineapple Festival is sponsored by the Lāna'i Community Association, the oldest nonprofit on the island which supports local groups such as youth sports, academic scholarships, senior activities and community events; and

WHEREAS, this free, family, and alcohol-free event will be held at Dole Park from 12:00 pm-9:00 pm on July 6, 2019;

THEREFORE I, DAVID Y. IGE, Governor, and **I, JOSHUA B. GREEN**, **Lieutenant Governor** of the **State of Hawai'i**, do hereby proclaim July 6, 2019 as

"PINEAPPLE FESTIVAL DAY"

in Hawai'i and encourage residents of the Aloha State and all of our visitors to celebrate Lāna'i, its history, heritage and contributions.
