

## Proclamation

WHEREAS, over the next decade, manufacturers will need to fill 4.6 million jobs across the country; and

WHEREAS, modern manufacturing is a technology-driven industry that offers secure, well-paying jobs; and

**WHEREAS,** manufacturers in Hawai'i account for 2.12 percent of the total output in the state, employing 2.16 percent of the workforce; and

**WHEREAS,** Manufacturing Day gives students, parents, teachers and community leaders an opportunity to learn about what manufacturing is and what it is not; and

**WHEREAS,** companies and educational institutions are encouraged to open their doors on Manufacturing Day to educate future generations, remove misconceptions about manufacturing, address the skilled labor shortage, and ensure prosperity of the manufacturing industry; and

**WHEREAS,** the Chamber of Commerce Hawai'i and INNOVATE Hawai'i will be hosting a manufacturing facilities tour to highlight the importance of manufacturing to our community and the U.S. economy; and

**WHEREAS,** the Chamber of Commerce Hawai'i, as the state's leading business organization since 1850, represents about 2,000 businesses, works on behalf of its membership to improve the state's economic climate and fosters positive action on issues of common concern; and

**WHEREAS,** the INNOVATE Hawai'i Program is administered locally by the Hawai'i Technology Development Corporation and assists small to medium-sized manufacturers and pre-manufacturers to expand their business for the global market;
