



WHEREAS, the Board of Land and Natural Resources at its meetings held on December 9, 2010 and May 24, 2019, approved the cancellation of the remaining portion of Governor's Executive Order 1786 dated May 1, 1957.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, DAVID Y. IGE, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Section 171-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, do hereby order that the remaining portion of Governor's Executive Order 1786 dated May 1, 1957, be and the same is hereby cancelled and declared of no force and effect.

SUBJECT to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.



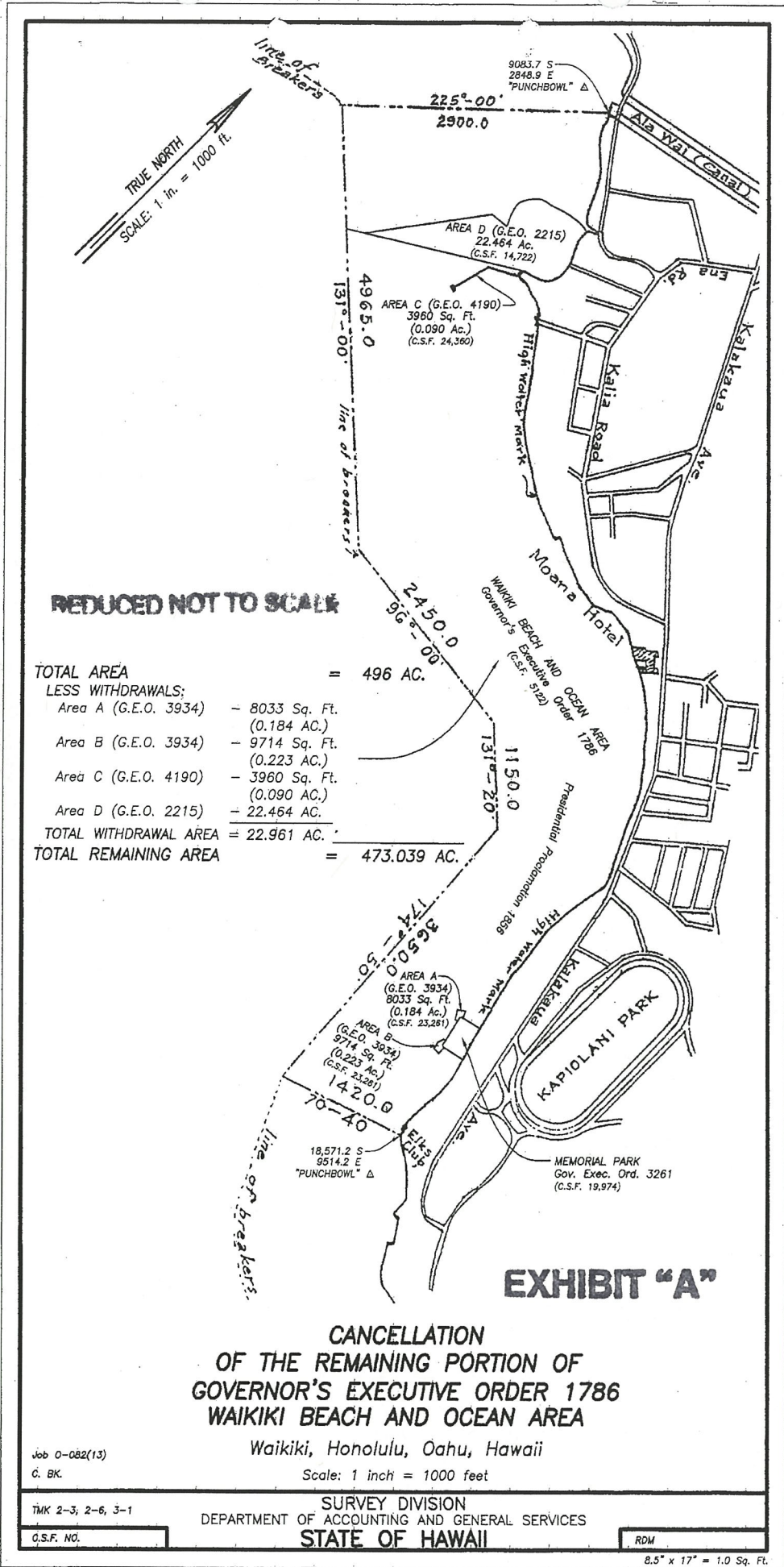
