





WHEREAS, the Board of Land and Natural Resources at its meetings held on December 9, 2010 and May 24, 2019, approved the cancellation of Governor's Executive Order No. 2170 dated October 15, 1964.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, DAVID Y. IGE, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Section 171-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, do hereby order that Governor's Executive Order No. 2170 dated October 15, 1964, be and the same is hereby cancelled and declared of no force and effect.

SUBJECT to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.


