EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 4621

SETTING ASIDE LAND FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES

BY THIS EXECUTIVE ORDER, I, the undersigned, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority in me vested by Section 171-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, and every other authority me hereunto enabling, do hereby order that the public land and improvements hereinafter described be, and the same is, hereby set aside for the following public purposes:

FOR MICROWAVE AND RADIO COMMUNICATIONS SITE PURPOSES, to be under the control and management of the State of Hawaii, Department of Accounting and General Services, Information and Communication Services Division, being:

"Pohakuwaawaa Microwave Antenna Site," situate at

PRELIM. APPR'D. Department of the Attorney General Hanalei and Waimea, Kauai, Hawaii, containing an area of 4000 square feet, TOGETHER WITH, Perpetual, Non-Exclusive Access and Utility Easement (20 ft. wide), more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, both being designated C.S.F. No. 25,760 and dated November 14, 2019, and

"Kukui Microwave Antenna Site," situate at Waimea, Kauai, Hawaii, containing an area of 1.251 acres, more particularly described in Exhibit "C" and delineated on Exhibit "D," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, both being designated C.S.F. No. 25,762 and dated November 14, 2019.

#### SUBJECT, HOWEVER, to:

- 1. The condition that upon cancellation of this executive order or in the event of non-use or abandonment of the premises or any portion thereof for a continuous period of one (1) year, or for any reason whatsoever, the State of Hawaii, Department of Accounting and General Services, Information and Communication Services Division shall, within a reasonable time, restore the premises to a condition satisfactory and acceptable to the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii.
- 2. The condition that the State of Hawaii, Department of Accounting and General Services, Information and Communication Services Division, accepts the subject land and improvements in an "as is" condition with all faults and defects, whether latent or patent.
- 3. The condition that if this set aside is cancelled in the future, the State of Hawaii, Department of Accounting and General Services, Information and Communication Services Division may be required to remove all improvements, restore the land to a condition satisfactory to the State of Hawaii, Department of Land and Natural Resources, and prepare a Phase I environmental site assessment.

SUBJECT, FURTHER, to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.

This executive order does not authorize the recipient of the set aside to sell or exchange or otherwise relinquish the State of Hawaii's title to the subject public land.


