

Mayor's Emergency Rule #8

The Beach Closures in Governor David Y. Ige's Seventh Supplemental Proclamation, and any subsequent proclamation, are not applicable to the County of Kaua'i. The beaches or sand bars within the County of Kaua'i may be utilized with the following restrictions:

- All groups are limited to a single residential or family unit sharing the same address;
- No group can exceed 10 persons;
- All persons using the beach, who are not part of a single residential or family unit sharing the same address, shall comply with social distancing requirements, provided that a caregiver may accompany a dependent;
- The beach or sand area may only be used one-half hour before sunrise to one-half hour after sunset, unless the person is engaged in shore fishing or permitted outdoor exercise; and
- All other restrictions found within the Safer at Home Order must be followed such as any applicable quarantine restrictions.

This rule is subject to specific beach closures as designated by the County of Kaua'i Ocean Safety Bureau and the State of Hawai'i Department of Land and Natural Resources.
