

Mayor's Emergency Rule #9

Traveling Inter-Island:

- 1. Pursuant to section 127A-13(a)(1), HRS, all persons traveling to the County of Kaua'i shall be subject to mandatory self-quarantine. The period of self-quarantine shall begin from the date of entry onto the island and shall last 14 days or the duration of the person's presence on the island, whichever is shorter.
- 2. Persons traveling between islands for purposes related to medical or health care will not be subject to the self-quarantine so long as they wear appropriate protective gear and follow the social distancing requirements identified in Section III.D of the Seventh Supplementary Proclamation.
- 3. Persons traveling to the County of Kaua'i to perform critical infrastructure functions as identified in Section III.A of the Seventh Supplementary Proclamation will be subject to self-quarantine but may break quarantine to perform necessary functions.
