EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 4631

AMENDMENT TO EXECUTIVE ORDER NOS. 1402, 2466, AND 3458 WHICH SET ASIDE LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES

WHEREAS, unrecorded Executive Order No. 1402 dated November 16, 1950, set aside land for a public park to the Board of Public Parks and Recreation of the City and County of Honolulu for Keaau Park;

WHEREAS, unrecorded Executive Order No. 2466 dated October 20, 1969, set aside to the City and County of Honolulu, Department of Parks and Recreation, additional land for the Addition to Keaau Park; and

WHEREAS, unrecorded Executive Order No. 3458 dated June



12, 1990, further set aside to the City and County of Honolulu for its Department of Parks and Recreation, additional land for Addition to Keaau Park; and


WHEREAS, at its meeting held on April 9, 2020, as amended, the Board of Land and Natural Resources approved the amendment of Executive Order Nos. 1402, 2466, and 3458, to amend the purpose to be for "PARKS AND COMMUNITY NEEDS (HOMELESS SERVICES) AND SOCIAL SERVICES PURPOSES".

NOW THEREFORE, BY THIS EXECUTIVE ORDER, I, the undersigned, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority in me vested by Section 171-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, and every other authority me hereunto enabling, do hereby order that the public lands and improvements hereinafter described be, and as set forth in Executive Order Nos. 1402, 2466, and 3458, and the same are, hereby amended for public purposes being "FOR PARKS AND COMMUNITY NEEDS (HOMELESS SERVICES) AND SOCIAL SERVICES PURPOSES."

SUBJECT, HOWEVER, to the condition that upon cancellation of these executive orders or in the event of non-use or abandonment of the premises or any portion thereof for a continuous period of one (1) year, or for any reason whatsoever, the City and County of Honolulu shall, within a reasonable time, restore the premises to a condition satisfactory and acceptable to the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii.

SUBJECT, FURTHER, to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.

This executive order does not authorize the recipient of the set aside to sell or exchange or otherwise relinquish the State of Hawaii's title to the subject public land.
