### FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

**JULY 9, 2020**

Today, July 9, 2020, President Donald J. Trump granted a Major Disaster Declaration for the State of Hawaii triggering the release of Federal funds to help communities recover from Severe Storms and Flooding that occurred March 27-28, 2020. Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:

Declaration Number:	FEMA-4549-DR
Incident:	Severe Storms and Flooding
Incident Period:	March 27-28, 2020
Federal Coordinating Officer:	Colby Stanton National FCO Program
Public Assistance (PA):	(Assistance for emergency work and the repair or replacement of disaster-damaged facilities):
PA-Designated Areas:	Kauai County.
Hazard Mitigation (HM):	(Assistance for actions taken to prevent or reduce long term risk to life and property from natural hazards):
HM-Designated Areas:	All areas in the State of Hawaii are eligible for assistance under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.

Additional designations may be made at a later date if requested by the State and warranted by the results of further assessments.
