EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 4655

SETTING ASIDE LAND FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES

BY THIS EXECUTIVE ORDER, I, the undersigned, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority in me vested by Section 171-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, and every other authority me hereunto enabling, do hereby order that the public land hereinafter described be, and the same is, hereby set aside for the following public purposes:

FOR CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE, REPAIR, OPERATION, AND MANAGEMENT OF PUBLIC ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS AND FOR ANCILLARY PURPOSES, to be under the control and management of the City and County of Honolulu, being those parcels of land situate at Kapalama, Honolulu, Oahu, Hawaii, and identified as follows:


"Kuakini Street Extension, Lot 1-A," containing an area of 1.249 acres, SUBJECT, HOWEVER, to portions of Drainage Easements 61-C and 61D, and subject, also, to all existing and applicable easements and encumbrances of record, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, both being designated C.S.F. No. 25,852 and dated April 14, 2021, and

"Portion of Royal Patent 3466, Land Commission Award 6732 to Nuuanu, Lot 2-B," containing an area of 0.079 acre, more particularly described in Exhibit "C" and delineated on Exhibit "D," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, both being designated C.S.F. No. 25,854 and dated April 14, 2021.

SUBJECT, HOWEVER, to the condition that upon cancellation of this executive order or in the event of non-use or abandonment of the premises or any portion thereof for a continuous period of one (1) year, or for any reason whatsoever, the City and County of Honolulu shall, within a reasonable time, restore the premises to a condition satisfactory and acceptable to the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii.

SUBJECT, FURTHER, to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.

This executive order does not authorize the recipient of the set aside to sell or exchange or otherwise relinquish the State of Hawaii's title to the subject public land.


