




meeting of December 7, 1990, approved the withdrawal of a portion of land from Executive Order No. 3074 dated August 20, 1981.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, DAVID Y. IGE, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Section 171-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, do hereby order that the following described land, identified as ""Withdrawal Portion of Keahole Airport, Governor's Executive Order 3074," situate at Kalaoa 1st-4th, North Kona, Island of Hawaii, Hawaii, containing an area of 4.00 acres, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, being designated as C.S.F. No. 22,156 and dated August 25, 1994, is hereby withdrawn from the Operation of Governor's Executive Order No. 3074 dated August 20, 1981.

SUBJECT to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.

Kalaoa 1st-4th, North Kona, Island of Hawaii, Hawaii

Being a portion of the Government Land of Kalaoa 1st-4th.

Beginning at the southeast corner of this parcel of land, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "AKAHIPUU" being 3895.77 feet South and 23,283.27 feet West, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 94° 50' 25" 250.00 feet along the remainder of Keahole Airport, Governor's Executive Order 3074;
2. 184° 50' 25" 697.30 feet along the remainder of Keahole Airport, Governor's Executive Order 3074;
3. 274° 50' 25" 230.00 feet along the remainder of Keahole Airport, Governor's Executive Order 3074;
4. Thence along the remainder of Keahole Airport, Governor's Executive Order 3074 on a curve to the right with a radius of 20.00 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being:

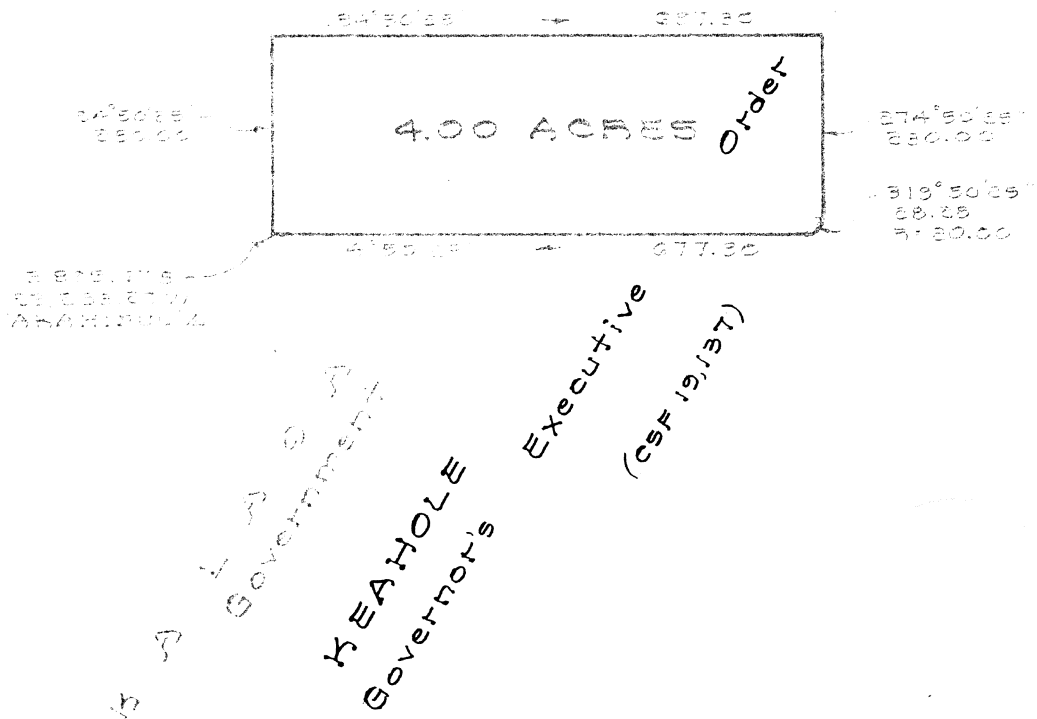
