

Proclamation

WHEREAS, according to the Center of Disease Control and Prevention, 1 in 8 couples have trouble getting pregnant or sustaining a pregnancy; and

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization and American Medical Association define infertility as a disease; and

WHEREAS, the LGBTQ community also faces challenges when building their families; and

WHEREAS, family building options include adoption and medical treatment, such as in vitro fertilization and third-party reproduction; and

WHEREAS, all people challenged in their family building journey should have access to all family building options; and

WHEREAS, cost and lack of insurance coverage are barriers for many in Hawai'i to access the family building option they need; and

WHEREAS, raising awareness of infertility and the barriers faced by the family building community is the first step to removing these barriers;

THEREFORE I, DAVID Y. IGE, Governor of the **State of Hawai'i,** do hereby proclaim April 24–30, 2022 as

"INFERTILITY AWARENESS WEEK"

in Hawai'i and ask the people of the Aloha State to join me in raising awareness of infertility; understanding and supporting infertile couples with hope; and recognizing the volunteers, health care professionals and members of the infertility and family building community for their dedication.
