

NOW, THEREFORE, I, DAVID Y. IGE, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Section 171-11 and Section 183-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, do hereby order that the following described land and improvements, identified as "Withdrawal Portion of Hamakua Forest Reserve, Governor's Proclamation dated December 22, 1928," situate at Honokaia, Hamakua, Island of Hawaii, Hawaii, containing an area of 238.00 acres, more or less, vehicle access into and from Hawaii Belt Road, Federal Aid Project No. F-019-1(1) shall not be permitted over and across Courses 1 to 5, inclusive, and 7 to 11, inclusive, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, being designated as C.S.F. No. 25,920 and dated February 4, 2022, is hereby withdrawn from the Operation of Governor's Proclamation dated December 22, 1928.





Being all of Grant S-15,986 to Boy Scouts of America, Aloha
Council.

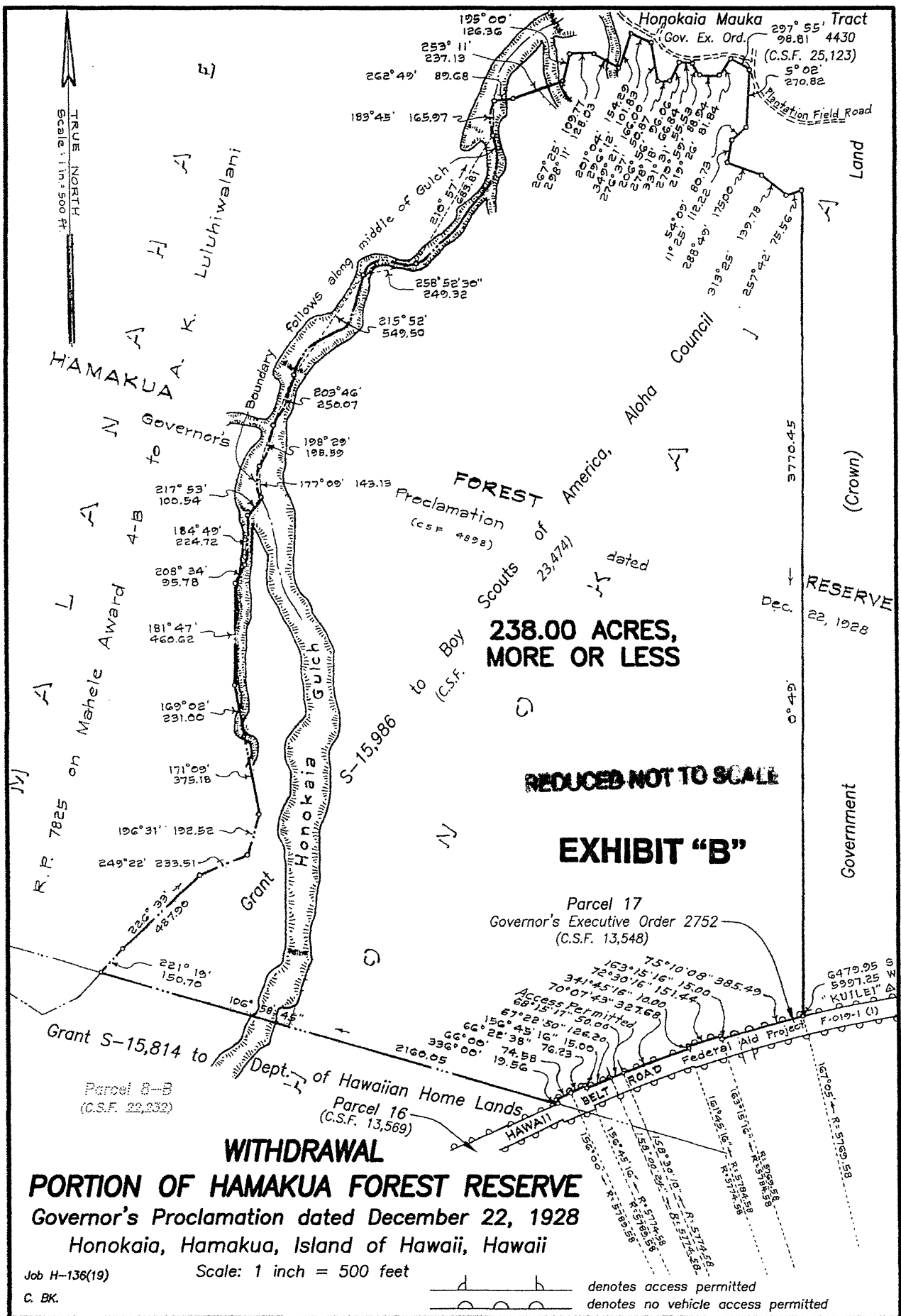
