

NOW, THEREFORE, I, DAVID Y. IGE, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Section 171-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, do hereby order that the following described land and improvements, identified as "Withdrawal Portion of Ditch Right-of-Way, Governor's Executive Order 1598," situate at Waimanalo, Koolaupoko, Oahu, Hawaii, containing an area of 0.263 acre, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, being designated as C.S.F. No. 24,527 and dated September 12, 2007, is hereby withdrawn from the Operation of Governor's Executive Order No. 1598 dated November 27, 1953.

SUBJECT to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.



PORTION OF DITCH RIGHT-OF-WAY
Governor's Executive Order 1598

Waimanalo, Koolaupoko, Oahu, Hawaii

Being a portion of the Government (Crown) Land of Waimanalo.

Being also a portion of the Ditch Right-of-Way excepted and excluded from Grant 13,246 to Kyusul Lee and Pak Chin Ock Lee.

Beginning at the east corner of this parcel of land and on the east boundary of Grant 13,246 to Kyusul Lee and Pak Chin Ock Lee, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "WAIMANALO RIDGE" being 3854.16 feet South and 463.63 feet East, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

- 1. 58° 40' 477.09 feet along Grant 13,246 to Kyusul Lee and Pak Chin Ock Lee;
- 2. 157° 50' 24.31 feet along the remainder of Ditch Right-of-Way, Governor's Executive Order 1598;
- 3. 238° 40' 477.09 feet along Grant 13,246 to Kyusul Lee and Pak Chin Ock Lee;

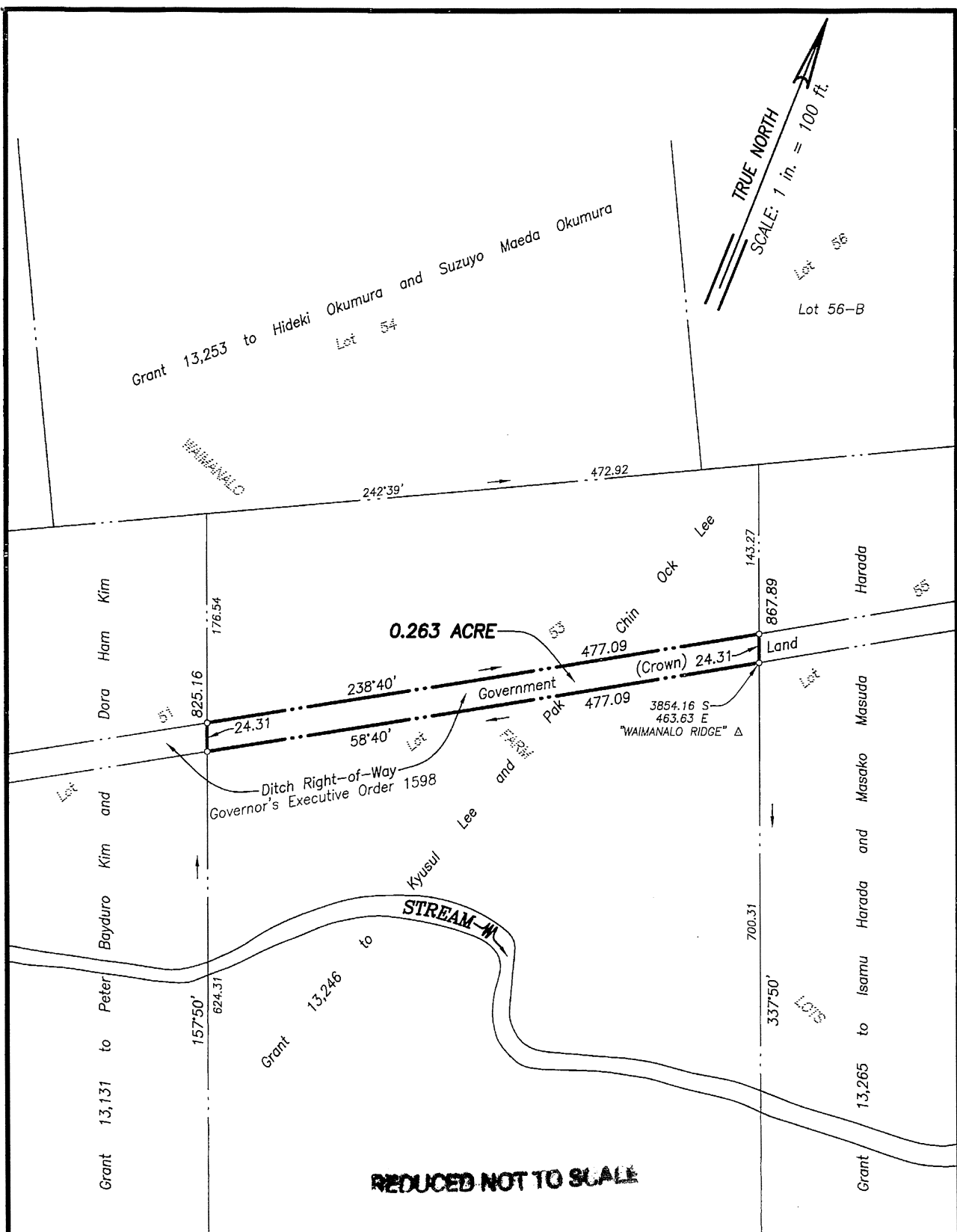
4. 337° 50'
