WITHDRAWING LAND FROM THE OPERATION OF GOVERNOR'S EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 1598 DATED NOVEMBER 27, 1953

WHEREAS, by Governor's Executive Order No. 1598 dated November 27, 1953, certain land and improvements situate at Waimanalo, Koolaupoko, Oahu, Hawaii were set aside for the operation and maintenance of an irrigation system to develop small scale farming; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Land and Natural Resources at its meeting of August 25, 2006, approved the withdrawal of a

portion of land from Executive Order No. 1598 dated November 27, 1953.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, DAVID Y. IGE, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Section 171-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, do hereby order that the following described land and improvements, identified as "Withdrawal Portion of Ditch Right-of-Way, Governor's Executive Order 1598," situate at Waimanalo, Koolaupoko, Oahu, Hawaii, containing an area of 0.263 acre, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, being designated as C.S.F. No. 24,527 and dated September 12, 2007, is hereby withdrawn from the Operation of Governor's Executive Order No. 1598 dated November 27, 1953.

SUBJECT to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.
