

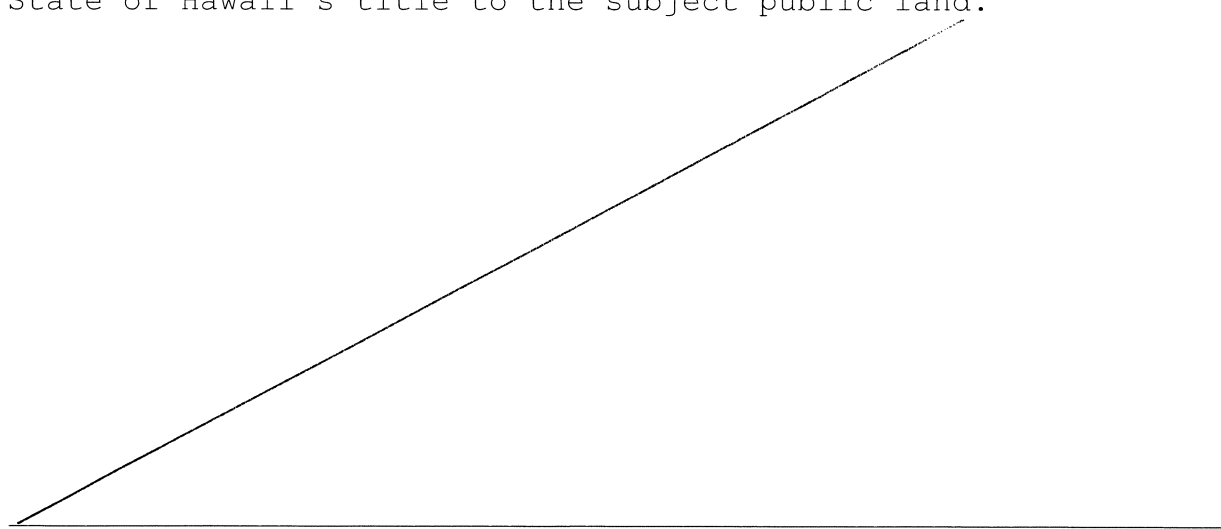


FOR WESTSIDE BASE YARD PURPOSES, to be under the control and management of the State of Hawaii, Department of Land and Natural Resources, Division of Forestry and Wildlife, being that parcel of land situate at Hanapepe, Waimea, Kauai, Hawaii and identified as "Hanapepe Baseyard Site," containing an area of 10.000 acres, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, both being designated C.S.F. No. 25,937 and dated May 2, 2022.


SUBJECT, HOWEVER, to the condition that upon cancellation of this executive order or in the event of non-use or abandonment of the premises or any portion thereof for a continuous period of one (1) year, or for any reason whatsoever, the State of Hawaii, Department of Land and Natural Resources, Division of Forestry and Wildlife shall, within a reasonable time, restore the premises to a condition satisfactory and acceptable to the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii.

SUBJECT, FURTHER, to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.

This executive order does not authorize the recipient of the set aside to sell or exchange or otherwise relinquish the State of Hawaii's title to the subject public land.

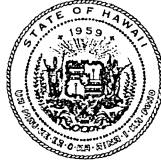

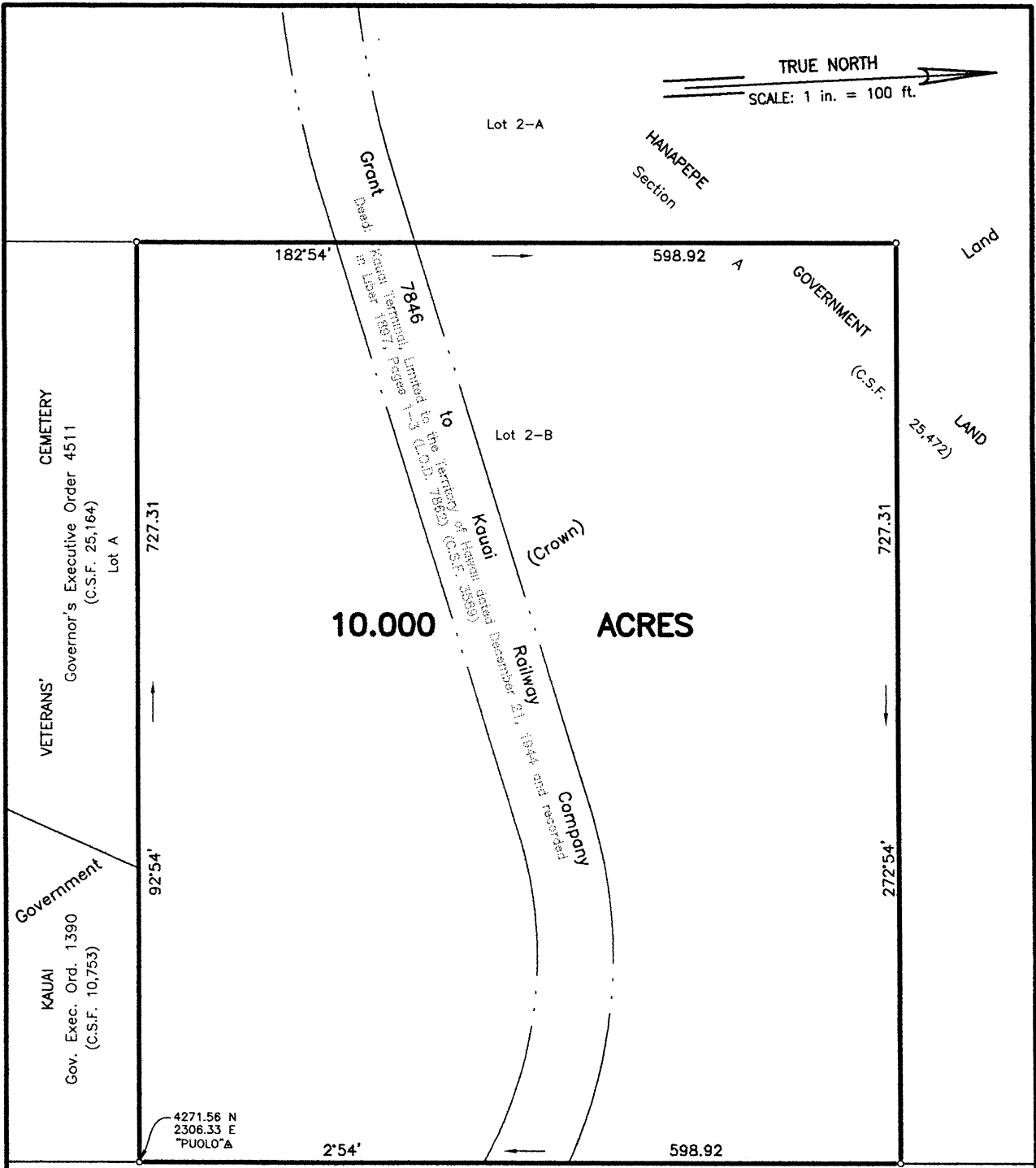
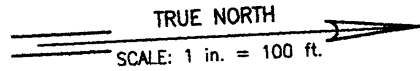
Comprised of the following:

- A. Portion of the Government (Crown) Land of Hanapepe.
- B. Portion of Grant 7846 to Kauai Railway Company conveyed to the Territory of Hawaii by Kauai Terminal, Limited by deed dated December 21, 1944 and recorded in Liber 1897, Pages 1-3 (Land Office Deed 7862).

Beginning at the southeast corner of this parcel of land, at the northeast corner of Kauai Veterans' Cemetery, Governor's Executive Order 1390 and on the west side of Lele Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "PUOLO" being 4271.56 feet North and 2306.33 feet East, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 92° 54' 727.31 feet along Kauai Veterans' Cemetery, Governor's Executive Orders 1390 and 4511;
2. 182° 54' 598.92 feet along the remainder of the Government (Crown) Land of Hanapepe;
3. 272° 54' 727.31 feet along the remainder of the Government (Crown) Land of Hanapepe;
